**Footnotes**

BROADWAY EMPIRE away slow, was close early, drifted slightly in the turn for the stretch the first time, was right close, went between rivals to take the lead in the backstretch then open up on the field and was much the best. REPORTING STAR was squeezed after leaving the gate, gapped out a bit, gained by the half, went four wide in the last turn and closed ground. SHOOTING JACKET was near the back, well off the pace, raced even, went up the rail and

finished a far back show. FOR CASH saved ground, stayed close, went up the rail in the third turn and rallied home for a small piece. DEADLY TRUTH was near the back, well off, raced even at the half, wide drive last turn to get the smallest prize. JUST WIN BABY chased outside, raced even, raced on inside down the backstretch and rallied home. SKIMMER JIM trailed to the three quarters, was four wide last turn but had no gain. TWO TO LOAD broke in, raced from the rail, chased, was close up at the half, went four wide in the last turn. SUCCESS RATE raced from the rail, was the pace setter to the half then was done after three quarters of a mile. RISKY CALL saved ground, stayed close up at the half, gained after the three quarters then faded. TITLE CONTENDER pushed to the lead not getting it, stalked two wide to the half, drift wide in the stretch the first time around continued to stalk and tired by the quarter pole. SMART PROMOTION stalked outside to the half, drifted a bit in the stretch the first time, fell back three lengths, tired after three quarters of a mile and gave way.
