J P'S GUSTO between horses early, stalked off the rail, went three deep on the turn, angled in and bid alongside the runner-up into the stretch, took the lead in upper stretch, inched away and drew clear under some urging and a strong hand ride. BELLEOFTHEBRIDLE went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the turn, fought back inside the winner into the stretch, was no match for that one in the final furlong but clearly second best. EDGEWICK ROAD stalked five wide then outside into and on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and just edged rivals for the show. GAB POWER close up stalking the pace between horses then outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for third between foes late. TAPPIN TOUGH bobbled slightly and steadied at the start, angled in outside a rival, went between foes nearing the turn, angled to the inside leaving the turn and lacked a rally. CLUBHOUSE RIDE broke a bit slowly, pulled his way up inside then just off the rail, came out into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and also could not offer the necessary response. LEON AYALA sped to the early lead, dueled outside the runner-up, stalked just off the rail on the turn, was between horses in midstretch and weakened.
