IL VILLANO the sole member of the field to leave the starting gate unscathed, set the pace from the inside facing only mild resistance all the while, was let out entering the stretch, held at the bay the only stretch threat to preserve the decision. LOVE THOSE BOOTS came out at the start, taking GLIB along for a short ride before making some contact, chased the winner throughout from the outside, had to settle for being second best. GLIB got carried in a bit before being bumped at the start, sat within range of the front runners and proved no match for either one. CLIP THE COUPONS came inward at the start, applying mild pressure from that direction as the runner up was applying similar pressure but from the opposite direction, gave chase three wide on the turn, was let out at notch coming to the five-sixteenths pole, failed to pick up the pace appreciably and tired. DANGEROUS TRICK bumped between rivals at the start, raced along the outside and tired. HARD NOSED sandwiched leaving the starting gate, left the backstretch three wide, folded. SUMMER SUNSET got bumped at the break, was asked early for run but steadily fell back nonetheless, faded.
