 MARCONI three wide through the first turn, settled three then two wide just off the pace, tipped out three wide put to coaxing at the three-eighths, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive to prevail. LONELY WEEKEND saved ground coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors. ROAMING UNION four then three wide in aim of the front, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, took over brief command spinning just off the inside for home, got displaced straightened away and weakened. HOARD chased three wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, improved position in the stretch. MATHEMATICIAN chased just off the inside under coaxing from the half mile pole, swung five wide for home, tired. JAMES CIRO three wide forwardly placed through the first turn, raced three then two wide in aim of the leader, took over command five furlongs from home, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. HOME RUN MAKER forwardly placed inside in front early on, traded the front with the aforementioned foe through to the far turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths yielding the front for the final time, cut the corner for home and faltered.
