WONDER GAL settled inside at the rear, advanced under light coaxing from three furlongs out quickly into prominence and angled to the three path at the five-sixteenths sharply, took over at the quarter pole, went clear under a light hand drive to the wire. ACCELEBRATE fractious behind the gate prior to being loaded, chased just off the inside from towards the rear, came under urging midway on the turn, angled four wide for home, improved position for the place honors in the last jumps by weakening foes. SALUDA dueled inside of HARLAN'S HONOR, got set down nearing the quarter pole headed for command by the eventual winner, cut the corner into upper stretch and weakened. HARLAN'S HONOR dueled just off the inside to the outside of the aforementioned foe under light coaxing, got let out near the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. JIGGIN WITIT three to four wide in pursuit through the turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, continued three to four wide for home and tired.
