FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each on or before Thursday, July 3 or by supplementary nomination of \$2,000 each by closing time of entries. Closed with 12 nominations. \$1,500 additional to start. The owner of the winner to receive \$60,000, \$20,000 to second, \$12,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth and \$2,000 to fifth. Weight 121 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than claiming allowed 3 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by closing time of entries. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference will be given to high weights based upon weights assigned as prescribed in the above conditions and adjusted for 'sex allowance'. Horses nominated to the Los Alamitos Futurity will not be charged the \$150 nomination fee (Los Alamitos Futurity horses are not automatically nominated to the Willard L. Proctor Memorial Stakes). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

Footnotes

STORY TO TELL stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, bid in the four path into the stretch, drifted in a bit, gained the lead in upper stretch and drifted in some, then inched away in the final sixteenth under energetic handling and a long hold late. BAD READ SANCHEZ stalked inside then bid along the rail, took back a half mile out, came off the fence on the turn, re-bid between horses into the stretch while being floated out some, drifted in a bit and bumped a rival, fought back just off the rail but could not match the winner. PERADVENTURE had speed outside then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled a bit off the rail into the stretch, was bumped in upper stretch and weakened but held third. LITIGATION ROAD angled in and saved ground, came out some in upper stretch then drifted in and did not rally. A claim of foul by the rider of PERADVENTURE against the top pair for alleged interference in upper stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the light contact between the runners did not alter the original order of finish.
