THAT'S THE IDEA was hustled away four wide to set the early pace, drew quickly clear then drifted out some in the stretch and proved best. LADY GENIUS chased the early leader four wide, vied into the stretch then flattened late. ZESTY SALSA prompted the early pace racing off the rail then tired after a half and weakened. ROLLSETROLL was unhurried early, went four wide and lacked a late response. MOON RISING was outrun early five wide and lacked a gain late. BONNIES PRINCESS raced mid pack seven wide and failed to threaten. I B RUSHING was off slow and improved her position in the stretch. TRICKY WHO was off slow early, went three wide and faded. BIRDIE BREW showed little in a dull effort. DEVIOUS raced wide then dropped back and was not a factor.
