FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$3,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race held at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible to receive a one time \$100,000 bonus should that horse go on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2014. The bonus will be reflected in the horse's earnings. 121 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming 2 lbs.; Maidens 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 5, 2014 with 15 Nominations.

FASHION ALERT broke in and bumped soundly with EVERYBDYMSTGETSTONZ then was pulled off that rival with the right rein, recovered pretty quickly then gathered momentum, moved up on the outside to press the pace, drew even with the leader at the half-mile pole, vied outside on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, fought with the runner-up into the final furlong then inched clear under a strong left-handed whip. TAKE CHARGE BRANDI was reluctant to load, came away alertly, avoided the bumping to her inside, quickly went clear, was challenged on the outside after running a sixteenth, set the pace under pressure, vied along the rail on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, fought with the winner into the final furlong and was outfinished while well clear for the place. TULIRA'S STAR was bumped on both sides at the start then in tight, moved out while urged along off the pace, went three to four wide on the turn and was best of the rest. EVERYBDYMSTGETSTONZ was bumped on both sides at the start then squeezed back, moved in at the rear while urged along, raced a bit off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to respond. MAST COVE came away well, bumped with TULIRA'S STAR just after the start, was urged along while off the pace, moved out near the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and faltered. Purse includes a \$100,000 NYRA 2-year-old Graded Stakes Bonus paid out to Fashion Alert.
