STRAPPING GROOM sat reserved within range two wide on the turn, got tipped into the three path during the initial portion of the stretch run, picked up the interest after finishing the maneuver, drew even with the runner up in the final seventy yards, took over and edged away. DADS CAPS took control shortly after the start, was placed along the inside well before reaching the end of the homestretch, was rated along while setting the splits, faced a still challenge coming from JAKE N ELWOOD approaching the quarter pole, showed good determination to repulse it, offered further resistance when confronted by the winner afterwards before relinquishing. SATURDAY'S CHARM saved ground for most of the opening half, commenced the stretch four wide, mustered up a mild response to take the show award. JAKE N ELWOOD pressed the issue from the two path, challenged in earnest as the half was being completed, got shaken off and weakened steadily thereafter. NON STOP on the track several minutes before the rest of the post parade, got brushed at the start, chased taking the two path on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. CANDYMAN E two wide entering the turn, was spun six wide exiting it, tired. SENSATIONAL SLAM brushed at the start, was three wide midway on the turn, fanned seven wide, the widest of all into the stretch, trailed.
