DISCREET MARQ came away in good order, rated kindly while cutting the pace, placed at a slight distance from off the rail, felt the presence of the closest pursuers and was set down in response to all potential challengers spinning into the stretch, dug in with good determination to fend them all off, crossing the wire under brisk hand encouragement. HEART OF NEW YORK made an early move towards the fence and settled down there well before reaching the end of the homestretch, was slow to settle into stride and dropped back to become the initial trailer, continued to take the inside route for the opening three-quarters, got asked for run and picked up interest cutting the corner into the lane, altered course a couple of paths in the direction of the middle of the course in upper stretch, displayed good late foot to outfinish MARIEL N KATHY for the place. MARIEL N KATHY assumed a forward position soon after the start, patiently prompting the winner from the two path, doing so while being rated along until the quarter pole, got roused and entered the stretch, finished willingly but had to settle for the show. FLY AGAIN tracked the top one from the pocket, failed to fire when called upon for the stretch run. HEADING TO TOGA three wide around both turns, lacked the necessary stretch response. COCONUT SHRIMP unhurried for over a half while racing along the outside, was let out a notch at the five-sixteenths pole in an attempt to pick up the pace, fanned four wide into the stretch, came up empty. FLASHY GAL hung out in the four path on the opening bend, was a bit closer on the subsequent one, remained a prominent factor for six furlongs before backing away. FLATTERMEWITHROSES underwent a three wide journey and tired.
