FASHION ALERT lunged at the start, got pulled away from the nearest opponent, was hustled the rest of the way down the backstretch into a forward position, entered the turn three wide vying for command, gradually shook off the other twosome to spin into the stretch with none latched on, got set down, responded positively to kick away, kept to a drive. LIATRIS saved ground during the initial stages, failed to get pick up the pace after initially receiving some attention with the stick near the area of the right shoulder, was put to hand urging upon reaching the turn, commenced to get angled four wide into the stretch leaving the five-sixteenths marker, continued onward to be second best. LINDY disputed the pace from between foes to the five-sixteenths pole before backing away. DADS LITTLE GIRLS three wide entering the turn, was fanned into the six path during the opening phases of the stretch, failed to menace. JULIE'S INDY took up the chase in the two path on the turn, was placed four wide at the head of the stretch, folded. AWESOMENDENSOME argued for command inside another pair to near the five-sixteenths pole and faltered.
