GAME ON DUDE stalked early then went up to the lead brushing the runner-up into the first turn, set the pace along the rail, responded when that rival challenged into the second turn to inch away again, fought back under left handed urging in the stretch and edged away again late. NONIOS bobbled slightly but broke alertly, had speed between foes then took the early lead a bit off the rail, brushed with the winner into the first turn, stalked that one just off the fence or outside a rival, came under urging leaving the second turn, bid again alongside the winner in the stretch to reach even terms but could not quite match that foe late. KETTLE CORN three deep early, angled in on the first turn and stalked inside, came out leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and bested the others. RICHARD'S KID settled off the pace inside then a bit out from the rail, went outside a rival on the backstretch, continued off the fence into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. MAKE MUSIC FOR ME chased outside a rival then angled in on the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace, pulled some on the backstretch, continued along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened.
