DEBT CEILING, outrun early, came under pressure into the turn, advanced four wide past the five sixteenths marker, altered off the heels of TAKE TIME TO PRAY entering the stretch, was straightened away soon after, closed five wide under left handed pressure, leveled off to a nice stride taking over a sixteenth out then drew clear while under confident handling late. SILVERTONGUEDTOMMY broke on top, took outside pressure from SWEET EMMA ROSE, was nudged clear leaving the three eighths pole, widened the advantage while two wide into the lane, could not resist the winner but did stay willingly for the place. NEW ZONE saved ground chasing the pace and came on late along the rail to just get the show. SWEET EMMA ROSE, away alertly, prompted the pace three wide, gave futile chase from the head of the lane and faded. TAKE TIME TO PRAY, reluctant to load, raced four wide pursuing the pace, made a slight gain in mid stretch then flattened out. JOHN BAILEY, difficult to load, broke slowly and was outrun.
