SONIC BOOM went around the first turn in the three path taking an easy lead with his ears up, kept up the pace turning for home, dug in when asked for more and won driving. GORGEOUS KITTEN hugged the rail around the first turn while sitting well rated off the pace, turned for home going three wide then uncorked a rally down the lane. MY BARILEY stumbled badly out of the gate then bumped with HEMBREE while coming into stride, took a few jumps to recover and was forced to trail the field, stayed on the rail around both turns then closed willingly between horses. IMPOSING WILL went around both turns going two or three wide while running in the middle of the pack, swung four wide turning for home while uncoiling a rally. HEMBREE got squeezed at the start when MY BARILEY and GRAND MARAIS came in on him, came away unfazed then chased the leader but went very wide around the first turn, was able to get in to go two wide turning for home but got swallowed up by the field at the quarter pole and weakened from there. KALININGRAD was slow into stride then ran towards the rear, hugged the rail the whole way then showed brief speed at the quarter pole but flattened out for the drive. GRAND MARAIS stumbled at the start then bumped with HEMBREE, sat well rated off the pace while going three and four wide around both turns but lacked a rally when asked.
