INNER TURF FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$2,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 121 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; Maidens, 6 lbs. Winners preferred. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Footnotes

NEW MONEY HONEY took up residence in the two path in midpack after the break, sat reserved under a firm hold keeping watch on the front runners for the opening six furlongs, picked up interest during the last few jumps of the run around the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and once straightened away, took off with good speed after the leader, arrived at the eighth pole trailing by the barest of margins, fought her to the top shortly afterwards, went on to spar side by side with the runner up before kicking clear in the final seventy yards. RYMSKA (FR) secured a prominent position after the start, was coaxed prompting the pacesetter from the two path, ranged up to increase her presence as three quarters was being reached, was forced to take the three path for entrance into the stretch after JOUST had moved one path wider itself stepping into the stretch, forged her way to a slim lead, yielded to the winner a short distance past the furlong marker, fought with vigor to reclaim the lead until well under a sixteenth remaining and weakened. COASTED tracked the front runners sitting a loose pocket, was kept on hold awaiting options leaving the five-sixteenths pole, arrived at the quarter pole with sufficient clearance along the inside corridor to attempt to launch a rally, after JOUST went two wide into the stretch with the top one following suit by going wider herself, responded positively when given her cue putting together a good run during the ensuing furlong before flattening out. CREATE A DREAM stumbled at the start, raced while unhurried in the two path for over six furlongs, fanned out into path five from upper to midstretch, mustered up a mild response sufficient enough to claim the last major check. JOUST away to an alert beginning, established control in short order, cut over to the inside route before reaching the top of the backstretch, vied to retain the lead, matched up with the second place finisher out in the two path, was pulling on the bit a bit from the left side but otherwise went about her business in a professional manner, came under heavier pressure from the primary pursuer heading to the quarter pole, shifted into the two path when put to encouragement entering the stretch, got overhauled right around the furlong grounds, dropped back a bit, was forced to check when RYMSKA came in slightly in the general area of the sixteenth pole, recovered and didn't back away any further. CHUBBY STAR was checked after

stumbling at the start, rode the rail for three-quarters, got spotted three wide at head of the stretch, made no impact. DANCING WAVES (IRE) off to a sluggish start, saved ground to the quarter pole and trailed.
