**Footnotes**

CHOCOLATE RIDE set the pace early, angled off the rail in the far turn, repelled bids at the top of the lane and cleared the field in the final stages. BONDURANT stalked the pace early, made a three wide bid at the top of the lane, continued the bid inside the eighth pole but hung in the late stages. BLARP was unhurried early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, altered out further late in the stretch with some gain in the final stages. AIROFORCE tracked the pace early, made a bid from between horses entering the lane but weakened late in the stretch run. FLASHY CHELSEY trailed the field early, angled off the rail in the far turn with a belated gain in the stretch drive. SPECIAL OPS broke a bit slow, chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the far turn and faded down the lane. SUDDENBREAKINGNEWS steadied in the first turn, fanned into the seven path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch. SILENT WATERS steadied in the first turn, shifted into the three path in the far turn and was tired down the lane.
