Footnotes

AL QASR stalked BERNIE THE MAESTRO under patient handling, advanced outside that rival leaving the final turn, secured command in upper stretch, opened up a bit in midstretch, dug in tenaciously under urging to prevail, galloped out in distress from the heat and was vanned off. TARGET SIGHTED saved ground in a forward position, responded when asked in the stretch drive and finished gamely. AMEN KITTEN lacked speed, eased out to the three path leaving the final turn, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out. OLYMPIC THUNDER (BRZ) , squeezed back leaving the starting gate, was well back entering the final turn, saved ground on the turn, swung out entering the stretch, angled to the inner rail in upper stretch, eased out in midstretch and gamely closed between horses. ROYAL BENCH (IRE) , four wide the first turn, chased the pace while three wide on the next two turns and came up empty in the drive. BERNIE THE MAESTRO , clear leaving the first turn, set the pace along the rail and weakened in upper stretch. LE DELUGE lacked speed, was four wide leaving the final turn and failed to be a factor. COGNASHENE saved ground most of the race and failed to rally. ALL TOGETHER , three wide the first turn, stalked the pace and gave way on the final bend. SAINT DYNAFORMER , outrun, steadied in tight quarters along the rail entering the final turn, remained inside and failed to recover. BROXBORNE , steadied in traffic soon after the start, raced wide on all turns. KEY TO FAME , lightly steadied in close quarters on the first turn, dropped back.
