STAKES J. Kenneth Self Shelby County Boys and Girls Club S. Listed - Thoroughbred
 FOR THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$300 additional to start. With \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three year olds, 118 lbs; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over in 2012 allowed 3 lbs; of \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2012 allowed 5 lbs; of \$25,000 twice at any distance allowed 7 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 horses pass the entry box, preference will be (1) high weights (2) highest 2011-2012 earnings. Entry fee only will be refunded if failure to draw into race. Trophy to the winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be run at one mile and seventy yards on the main track).

A DIEHL settled back off the pace while off the inside, bid four wide into the lane and floated to mid-track while gaining momentum, continued with good energy and was up in time. NIGHT PARTY set the pace while along the inside, shook away after straightening and looked like a winner with a sixteenth to go and was caught. FINAL COUNT trailed while in the two or three path through the turn, angled back to the inside for the drive and was gaining while no match for the top two. CHEROKEE LORD was under a strong hold while pressing the pace into the far turn then was empty in the lane. LONESOME STREET was near the rail while never far back then lacked a closing response. UNION BOWMAN chased the pace from the three path into the turn then faded.
