GUAM TYPHOON set the pace from the break, saved ground through the turn then held a clear lead while under mild encouragement. NICOLE H was never far back, raced along the inside on the turn, then rallied late and was up for place. SLOANE RANGER was close up from the break, raced along the inside throughout then finished well. IMMORTAL EYES pressed the early pace, raced along the two path through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. PONZI SCHEME showed good early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then failed to sustain his bid. THE HUNK pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, then faded late. PEPPI KNOWS was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then was through after a half.
