SHARP SENSATION was well placed just off the speed, rallied in the stretch, closed determinedly, drew off late under left handed urging. SUM OF THE PARTS stalked the pacesetter through quick fractions, rallied at the top of the stretch and gained a slight lead, could not match strides late with the winner but was second best. TRIPLE CROSS was well placed and saved ground, finished willingly on the inside. DAZZLED SAINT set the early pace with a clear lead, gradually weakened in the stretch. STEVIS MAN allowed to settle early, passed tiring rivals four wide while no threat. CHOCTAW CHUCK had good position until the quarter pole, then gave way in the stretch. MISH MOSH raced four wide and lacked a rally. EVIL DOER showed little and was outrun. NEW TRACK RECORD
