ROMANSH settled just off the pace two to three wide, took closer order under his own power into the far turn to join the pair up front by midway, remained in hand and seized control nearing the quarter pole, got roused at the top of the stretch and went clear under a drive. NORUMBEGA three wide through the first turn, settled in mid pack, came under encouragement midway on the far turn four wide, angled in three wide into upper stretch under a drive, proved no match for the top one while running on willingly for the place. MICROMANAGE bumped at the start by BAD HOMBRE, saved ground settled in mid pack, came under light coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, began to angle out to the four path nearing the five-sixteenths to swing into upper stretch, offered up mild late foot for the show. BATTIER a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, was eased back after the start to settle just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, cut the corner into the stretch, angled to the three path at the three-sixteenths and passed tired foes in the late stages. MR PALMER off a half a beat slow at the start, saved ground towards the rear, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths and offered no serious response. MIDNIGHT TABOO cut the pace inside attended from the outside while racing in hand, got headed three furlongs from home, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths and weakened in the stretch. VEGAS NO SHOW attended the pace from just off the inside, took over placed to encouragement three furlongs out narrowly between foes, got headed nearing the quarter pole, chased into the stretch and weakened in a drive. BAD HOMBRE lunged slightly at the start bumping MICROMANAGE lightly, was in a bit tight into the first turn and was forced to be taken in hand at the eight and a half, settled just off the inside in mid pack, came under urging three furlongs out, spun three wide for home and tired.
