Footnotes

YOUR LOVE well off the inside throughout, departed the backstretch from the four path, contended for command as the widest of a quartet during the run around the bend, was still in reserve getting floated by DAWN THE DESTROYER out towards path six as they spun into the stretch, straightened away when finally given a chance to and was switched over to a drive, became the widest of a group of three fighting for the lead, saw the middle member of that bunch, that being DAWN THE DESTROYER, got impeded then denied the opportunity of offering her best in the final seventy yards by being checked, displayed good courage as the runner up continued to drift into her path, and got up, refusing to be intimidated. KIRBY'S PENNY grabbed command shortly after the start, settled towards the inside route, was successful fending off as many as three foes to her outside travelling on the bend, shifted more into the three path when put to a drive at the head of the stretch, was still holding the advantage at the beginning of the last eighth, began to come out during the run leading up to the sixteenth pole, briefly kept a straight course when put to a right side whip, came out several paths when the rider reverted back to a strong hand ride, carrying out the third place finisher, and even more towards the middle of the strip when put to the first of two left handed shots, eventually cutting over onto the path of DAWN THE DESTROYER and leading its rider to check itself out of contention, wasn't done being wayward, continued to move to the right after some abbreviated left side pressure, herded the winner a bit, but wound up losing a tight finish. DAWN THE DESTROYER broke forwardly placed and would remain so, was three wide and one of the middle participants among four front runners disputing the pace, sputtered five wide into lane, taking the top one along for a short ride, was put to a drive and fought against the top two for command, got carried out several paths by KIRBY'S PENNY in the final sixteenth, checked after that foe moved into her path in the final stages, then went on to secure the show. ANNA RAE on the rail down the backstretch, tipped out into path two at the end of the backstretch, made its presence felt as a pace factor from between rivals for most of the trip on the turn, was put to a drive heading into the stretch and gave way. SPRING FOR MORE in the two path and under a prolonged drive on the turn, tired. ASPEN HILLTOP four wide entering the turn, fanned out eight wide exiting it and was outrun. JUST GOT OUT got guided over to the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, wound up trailing off the subsequent ground-saving journey. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident in deep stretch, in addition to claims of foul lodged by the rider of DAWN THE DESTROYER against the riders of both YOUR LOVE and KIRBY'S PENNY alleging interference, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
