FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Colts and Geldings 122 lbs. Fillies 119 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming, allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than claiming, 4 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Bashford Manor will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights with consideration to the sex allowance. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 14, 2014 with 21 nominations.

Footnotes

CINCO CHARLIE set the pressured pace toward the inside, shook off SILVERHILL in the final yards and gamely edged clear. SILVERHILL prompted the pace three wide, was unable to go on with CINCO CHARLIE late but was clearly best of the rest. SKYWAY was put in tight and checked nearing the five furlong marker, moved up through the turn, shifted out three wide, offered a mild bid but failed to threaten the top two. LUCKY PLAYER bumped with GOVERNMENTSHUTDOWN near the nine-sixteenths pole, settled four wide and lacked a response when called upon. GOVERNMENTSHUTDOWN drifted about between horses, tightened up SKYWAY and came out to bump LUCKY PLAYER inside the five-eighths pole, floated out on the turn and came up empty after a half. DRAW NIGH dropped far back before going a quarter, was pulled up midway through the turn, but walked off.
