Footnotes

DREAMER'S POINT was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch four wide, drove past the leader and cleared the field in the final stages. CROSSWALK vied for the lead early three wide, was off the rail entering the lane, drew clear in the stretch but yielded late in the drive and was second best. SEAUXTALE came in at the start, chased the pace early, made a bid three wide entering the lane but weakened late in the stretch run. DROP KICK tracked the pace early four wide, shifted into the four path in the turn and faded down the lane. OVER RIDER was bothered at the start and raced back early, fanned into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. TIZPURE was never a threat. TENKOZ had early speed from between horses then folded up. MAJESTIC FORCE broke in at the start then was rushed up and was eventually spent. CHARLEY CAT was always outrun.
