STRATFORD HILL behind the leaders three wide, angled out for the drive, was floated out in midstretch then proved best in a hard drive. GRAND ADVENTURE reserved off the inside, angled well out in the strip for the drive and finished well to be steadily gaining late. GREAT ATTACK vied for the lead off the inside and despite drifting out through the stretch, held on gamely. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE alternated for the lead three wide, battled into deep stretch and weakened while being carried out.. STRIKE IMPACT reserved in the three path, angled out to the middle of the course for the drive and made a late gain. SILVER TIMBER close up between rivals, angled out for the drive, stayed on well to deep stretch, was pulled up quickly after the finish and was vanned off. GOLDZAR close up along the inside, weakened in the drive. KENNESSEY outrun to the stretch, never threatened.
