TALE FOR RUBY , bumped and steadied at the break, regrouped and was patiently handled well off the rail, cruised up four wide to reach striking position mid turn, angled out a path continuing progress between rivals into the lane, spurted away while shown the whip in mid stretch then was kept alert with some right handed encouragement the final seventy yards. TAKREES lagged back off the pace and removed from the rail, was put to a drive leaving the far turn, circled six wide outside the winner into the lane, could not kick on with that one nearing the eighth pole but kept on willingly to be clear for the place. OUTSIDER ART , off the early pace, advanced four wide between rivals around the turn, angled out for the drive and continued with interest. ULTRA BRAT advanced three wide between rivals mid turn then lacked the needed finish. JESSICA KRUPNICK , four wide stalking the pace, ranged up three wide mid turn, drew on even terms with a quarter to go, was overwhelmed soon into the lane and gave way. FORMBY advanced leaving the five eighths, steadied off

heels into the turn, saved ground into the lane, altered out near mid stretch and showed some late action. CLARE'S DOWERY , sluggish early, circled the turn very wide and had belated action. ATLANTIS ROMANCE took command early, set the pace outside a rival, moved clear into the turn, was confronted mid turn, stayed on to upper stretch then surrendered. MALIBU STACY stumbled at the break, edged up inside under urging near the five eighths, swung wide on the turn but failed to menace. PLEASANT MINE gave early chase and weakened. DECORATEDWITHSTYLE , four wide early, edged closer three wide mid turn, was under a hard ride into the lane and weakened. LITTLE CYCLONE was steadied while between rivals early and dropped back. KELSOCATIT stumbled at the break, hustled up inside soon after, vied into the turn and faltered.
