ZAZU broke a bit slowly, angled in early then came off the rail on the first turn, went around BLIND LUCK on the backstretch, came out three deep into the stretch, rallied under some urging and strong handling to gain the lead four wide past the sixteenth pole and gamely prevailed. ULTRA BLEND bobbled at the start, settled a bit off the rail, came out three wide into the stretch, bid between horses three deep a sixteenth out and continued willingly to the wire. GREAT HOT (BRZ) three deep early, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, inched forward then waited a bit early on the second turn, got through along the fence into the stretch, came out in midstretch, bid between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished late but clearly bested the others. CHAMPAGNE D'ORO sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, responded when ASK THE MOON loomed up into the second turn, inched away again, kicked clear under urging, fought back in deep stretch and weakened late. LOVE THEWAY YOUARE chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. ASK THE MOON stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into the second turn, continued outside GREAT HOT leaving that turn, drifted inward in the stretch and weakened. BLIND LUCK settled inside, saved ground off the pace, fell back into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch, lacked a further response and was eased in the final furlong.
