REVVED UP settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, tipped out three to four wide three furlongs from home and was under a hard hold briefly off the heels of NESSY, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung five wide into upper stretch, rallied with a good kick to take command narrowly a furlong out, ding donged down to the finish head to head with CALL PROVISION to his inside and repelled that rival on the wire in game fashion. CALL PROVISION saved ground near the rear, remained patiently handled as rivals circled outside, got set down angled three wide into upper stretch, offered up a good kick to issue a challenge a furlong out, hooked up with the aforementioned foe head to head and battled gamely to the finish but was ultimately rebuffed on the wire. TASIT off half a beat slow, settled just off the inside at the tail of the field, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, closed well outside to garner the show honors. SPRING UP just off the inside just off the pace, tipped three wide half a mile from home, came under urging stacked four wide with five-sixteenths remaining, continued four wide into upper stretch, kept on but was outkicked in the late

stages. GIO'S CALLING saved ground in mid pack initially set up behind the cover of TATHQEEF until that rival tipped to the two path half a mile from home, took up residence midway on the far turn in behind the leader, had that foe weaken in front and was mildly shuffled from the five-sixteenths to the quarter pole when able to move around that rival taking the two path into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid before weakening in the late stages. NESSY coaxed from the start, raced three to four wide through the first turn before settling three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, came under coaxing five-sixteenths out, drifted in to the two path straightened away for home and weakened in the stretch. ST. LOUIE three wide through the first turn, attended the pace of WAR STROLL three then two wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths and taking over command, cut the corner into upper stretch under threat from a host, succumbed and weakened in the stretch. TATHQEEF broke awkwardly at the start, tracked the pace along the inside until tipped to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing with three furlongs to run, cut the corner into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. SOLUBLE (GER) two to three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing taking the overland through the third and final turn, swung seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a run of the outside, went head to head with that rival down the backstretch through moderate splits, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, got headed for command with five-sixteenths to go, faded nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner for home and folded.
