Footnotes

ON RAINBOW BRIDGE stalked the pace, chased five-wide into the stretch, bid a furlong out and drew clear under light handling. PALADIN BAY pressed the pace, chased late turn, bid upper stretch, dueled but was outfinished and steadied slightly right on the wire. LIA'S MIRACLE raced in midpack, chased late turn, bid along the rail upper stretch, yielded midstretch, moved off the rail and finished gamely holding 3rd. LEXIE LOU stalked the pace, chased five-wide, was hustled seven-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. ITS A GIZMO stalked the 3rd pace, chased four to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. STRELA, rated off the pace, closed late turn but flattened out in the final 16th. MAKING IT HAPPEN emerged with the lead on the backstretch, quickened on the turn, was headed upper stretch but had no further response. EXECUTIVE CLASS settled off the pace, chased late turn but never reached contention. WHERE'S THE CARAT settled in midpack, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
