THE LUMBER GUY took up a forward position soon after the start, made his presence felt while stalking the front runners from the three path, moved up approaching the quarter pole and bid in earnest at that station, reached the end of the furlong grounds with only a narrow deficit to make up, continued onward and arrived at the sixteenth pole in possession of the lead and with none latched on, dug in stubbornly to stave off the fast-closing runner up, crossing the finish line under a vigorous hand ride. CAIXA ELETRONICA was taken hold shying away from JUSTIN PHILLIP shortly after the start, sat well reserved from off the inside for nearly a half, picked up interest and swung slightly more than three wide into upper stretch, kept fanning wider yet until in the five path by the three-sixteenths pole, kicked in with a strong response once that maneuver was done and closed in with good late energy en route for the place. POSEIDON'S WARRIOR hooked up with LITTLE DRAMA almost from the start, was taken over to the rail a short distance from the half mile pole, continued to argue with the aforementioned foe with both the eventual winner and his entry make in close proximity as well, got asked for a response heading for the top of the lane, held off all challengers during the ensuing furlong, but only barely, relinquished a few jumps leaving the eighth pole but finished willingly to hold on to the show award. LITTLE DRAMA disputed the pace from the two path until the furlong grounds, weakened in the last eighth. SEAN AVERY well placed in the pocket off a contested pace, came up empty for the stretch run. JUSTIN PHILLIP off the inside, failed to menace. FORT LOUDON saved ground early, was fanned outward to be six wide by three-sixteenths pole, had no rally. ZERO RATE POLICY was rank under stout restraint nearing the end of backstretch as POSEIDON'S WARRIOR was tucking along the rail, tracked the front runners from the inside and faltered. ROTHKO raced along the outside and folded.
