FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination payment of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken their maiden in a race at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 which will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2012. 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race, 4 lbs.; maidens, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, September 15, 2012 with 22 nominations.

KAUAI KATIE came away in good order and moved up to become the primary pursuer, patiently stalked the pacesetter from the two path for nearly a half, ranged up quickly from the five-sixteenths marker and wrested away the lead, turned for home with the former pacesetter barely latched on, extended the margin during the ensuing furlong, placed to solid hand encouragement, was kept to it until just past the sixteenth pole before allowed to finish under her own power. BABY J stumbled at the start, got put to early light hand urging and secured the advantage, was swung over to the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, got let out a notch as the winner was making her presence more noticeably late on the turn but nonetheless surrendered the lead soon afterwards, dug in well enough during the stretch drive to preserve the place. SEASONED WARRIOR perched three wide, got set down spinning into the lane and came up empty. UNABASHED tipped into the two path midway on the turn, was under a drive about a sixteenth down the road, made no headway on the front runners. DOUBLED put to a prolonged drive, ducked over to the rail and rode it for about a furlong starting from the three-eighths pole, swung outward gradually turning for home until four wide in upper stretch, tired.
