UNCLE MO reserved while racing off the inside and in closest attendance to the pace, challenged when ready on the second turn, disposed of RIVETING REASON and repulsed BOYS AT TOSCONOVA approaching the stretch, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while under steady urging. BOYS AT TOSCONOVA drifted out a bit when within striking distance and near the rail on the first turn, moved to a challenging position outside the winner approaching the stretch, could not keep pace with that one in the stretch but clearly second best. ROGUE ROMANCE fanned five wide on the first turn, was reserved for a half, raced three wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive and improved his position while no threat. BIONDETTI carried out a bit on the first turn when restrained, moved up in traffic into the second turn, made a solid run to the quarter mile marker but tired in the drive. STAY THIRSTY forwardly placed three wide, made a good four wide middle move to a forward position approaching the stretch, drifted in with a furlong to go and tired. J P'S GUSTO carried out a bit on the first turn, was outrun for a half, raced near the rail on the second turn and was no threat. JAYCITO steadied entering the first turn from between rivals, swerved out past the middle of the strip entering the backstretch, angled back in nearing the second turn, got to the rail for the stretch run and could not menace. RIVETING REASON set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. J. B.'S THUNDER forwardly placed near the rail, gave way in the drive. MURJAN four wide on the first turn, never menaced.
