KATHY'S SONG stalked inside, came off the rail leaving the backstretch, went three deep between foes on the second turn, bid outside the pacesetter into the stretch to gain the lead, inched clear and held on gamely under urging. LASEEN (IRE) saved ground stalking the pace, waited off heels on the second

turn, steadied in close leaving the turn, awaited room again into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and surged between foes late. HOW UNUSUAL angled in and settled outside a rival then between foes on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and finished well while outside the top pair. NODIAC (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, also went between horses on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and bested the others. STARLITE STYLE chased inside, came out into the stretch, was between rivals under urging in midstretch then had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out and lacked the needed late kick. DYNAMIC MIZZES K angled in and chased outside a rival then three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. JEREMY'S LEGACY (IRE) broke in and steadied in a bit of a slow start, settled outside a rival, moved up four wide leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, bid three wide into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DIS SMART CAT pulled his way up outside the pacesetter then stalked off the rail on the first turn, bid again outside that one on the backstretch, continued just off the inside on the second turn and between foes into the stretch and weakened. THERMODYNAMICS pulled early, chased outside a rival, was in a bit tight between foes leaving the backstretch, angled in some leaving the second turn and also weakened. KHALEESI (BRZ) sped to the early lead and angled in, inched clear on the first turn, responded when challenged again, edged away again on the second turn, fought back into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong.
