EXIT STAGE LEFT was a pace factor from the outset, responded when roused on the second turn, dug in determinedly through a long drive and held gamely. ENTERPRISING stalked the leaders to the second turn, bid inside to the stretch, eased off the rail in upper stretch, rallied when set down but could not catch the winner. INFOSEC settled mid pack to the half, offered a bid three wide on the second turn, rallied to loom a threat to mid stretch but could not sustain the needed response. PUPPY MANNERS had no speed, was outrun to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch then closed ground steadily through the lane. ARGYLE CUT was settled for a half mile, raced two wide on the second turn but could not make an impact in the drive. ROYAL BANKER (GB) had no speed, moved up nearing the second turn, was fanned four wide to the stretch then flattened in mid stretch. HARBAUGH attended the pace for six furlongs while two wide but tired in the stretch. MORALLY BANKRUPT (GB) tracked the leaders to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then gave way.
