Footnotes

RUSHING FALL was unhurried near the tail of the field, came under a ride with three furlongs to run, picked off runners through the second turn, wheeled out seven wide entering the stretch, was full bore once straightened for the drive, came in with a furlong to run and tightened up foes to her inside, quickly shook off her rivals and drew away. STAINLESS was unhurried along the inside, moved with the winner through the second turn between horses, was unable to go on with that one, altered to the outside of RUSHING FALL and continued on well to earn the place. CASH OUT settled in hand four wide, moved up five wide to make a bold bid, churned on between horses and just failed to earn the place. LAYLA NOOR was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, kept on well in tight in traffic and improved position. SUGAR QUEEN tracked three wide, moved up to engage the leaders leaving the

second turn, but weakened slightly during the drive and gave way. SUNNY SKIES settled in hand between horses within striking distance, but flattened in tight quarters in traffic in the final furlong. MENTALITY opened clear to dictate terms toward the inside, was headed inside the furlong marker and gave in. ROSIE O'PRADO broke slow, was unhurried, angled out but found her best stride too late. PUNTO DE ENTRADA contended off of the inside to the stretch and faltered. SHE'S ALL SKEET was close up four wide to the final furlong and tired. BREAKING BEAUTY contended between horses for six furlongs and faded. MADAME X. settled between horses and lacked a response when called upon. LADY O'TOOLE saved ground to no avail. MISS MO MENTUM was forwardly placed along the inside through the second turn and stopped.
