Footnotes

CANDIR saved ground on the first turn, was well placed off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, spun into the two path turning into the stretch, rallied to make a bid at the furlong marker, drifted out while in front into the final sixteenth, was straightened by the rider and held under strong urging. PATERNAL PRIDE dropped to the rail early on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while inside in upper stretch, steadied behind the leading duo just inside the furlong marker, altered course outside those foes and finished with good energy but missed. TOPCATMARK set the pace on the inside, was asked on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and was outfinished while able to get the show. EARLY RIDE was a bit eager into the first turn, shifted to the two path early on that bend, settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch behind horses then was roused, gained into the final sixteenth, was taken up behind horses late and finished willingly. U. S. A. COWBOY stalked the pace in the two path, was asked on the far turn, spun three wide into the stretch and came up empty. ISH RULES went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and capitulated. BLANCO GRANDE went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. PACIFIC TYPHOON went five then four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging near the three-eighths, went four wide on the far turn, spun five wide into the stretch and had nothing left. (Rail at 10 Feet)
