ON FIRE BABY four wide into the first turn when unhurried, stalked and moved a bit closer late backstretch while remaining well out in the strip, ranged up to engage the leader far turn, dueled with that foe, roused, fully extended to race that same foe into submission with less than an eighth of a mile remaining. AMIE'S DINI broke sharp, set a moderate pace the first half mile while rating, responded when the winner came alongside with three furlongs remaining, continued to hold a narrow advantage past the furlong marker and gave ground grudgingly to the winner. COLONIAL EMPRESS allowed pace to go, saved ground, went one paced to the wire and was no match for the top two, remained clear of the others. SILVER HUSTLER last to leave, advanced off the inside, four wide through the final turn when heading up the second flight, no late gain. OUR DOMAIN away with the field, settled off the pace and the inside, three wide and between rivals into the lane, also failed to muster a late bid. INCA MISS lacked speed, shifted out a bit for room when straightened for home, no response. FORGOTTEN PEOPLE saved ground to no avail. ROCKET TWENTYONE pressured the runner up early outside that foe, stopped.
