FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. Weights: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2013 allowed 3 lbs.; non-winners of \$18,000 in 2013 allowed 5 lbs.; non-winners of \$15,000 in 2013 allowed 7 lbs.; non-winners of \$9,000 in 2013 allowed 9 lbs. No nomination fee. \$350 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start. \$60,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$1,200 TO ENTER AND START. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds ten (10), high weights will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second parts of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees.

The latter was reserved, cruised up while four wide on the far turn, loomed a serious threat while three wide into the stretch, kept on but failed to get on terms with the top one. BLACK BEAR raced in striking position while three wide, was urged on the far turn and lacked a rally. KING HENNY was outrun and managed to pass tiring rivals. I STAND ALONE settled while four wide and failed to threaten. MUPPET MAN vied between foes for six furlongs, was urged on the far turn and faded. MY BROTHER DON chased along the inside and faltered.
