SO LONG GEORGE stalked the pace, closed along the rail late turn, bid 3/16ths out, drove to the lead and held under steady pressure. HAMPSTEAD HEATH settled off the pace, closed two-wide into the turn, stalked, chased into the stretch, jostled with RIDING THE RIVER briefly then came with a strong rally and was getting to the leader. GRAND ARCH dueled then forced the pace, rebid midturn, dueled, was passed upper stretch and chased gamely to the end. CLASSIC BRYCE raced off the pace, angled five-wide late turn and rallied late outside rivals. VALENTINO BEAUTY led briefly then was taken back and stalked the duel, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then lacked a closing response. HOTEPE settled in midpack, chased hard four-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. RIDING THE RIVER, in range, chased five-wide into the stretch, jostled with a rival at the head of the stretch then tired in the final furlong. POOL PLAY settled off the pace, saved ground, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. PENDER HARBOUR raced in midpack, came four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but lacked a late response. ARTIC FERN dueled, took a short lead

late backstretch, was joined midturn, dueled but was passed upper stretch and tired.
