Footnotes

LONG RIVER drifting out slightly after losing his footing at the start, sat reserved and within range of the pacesetter at or near the rail for the opening three-quarters, slipped towards the three path to be outside of the runner up leaving the five-sixteenths pole, got set down for the drive home, whittled away at the lead, poked a head in front with about a sixteenth remaining and edged away, hand urged while crossing the finish line. PERCUSSION away in good order, established control, sat entrenched in the two path, cutting the pace while being rated, felt the presence of the eventual winner during the last stages of the run around the far turn, got set down entering the stretch, was given some light left handed stick work and allowed to drift outward enough to draw directly alongside the top one past the eighth pole, relinquished near the sixteenth marker and although continuing onward with good determination, had to settle for being second best. JONESY BOY raced from off the inside throughout, departed the backstretch three wide, got fanned outward during the initial portion until in the six path midway through the furlong grounds, rallied for the show award. CEASE strung out four wide on the opening bend, issued an abbreviated challenge for command down the backstretch, continued from off the inside on the second bend, tired. DON DULCE was sent onto to the inside early, proceeded down the backstretch, put to some light hand coaxing, cut the corner into the drive under a full drive, made no headway. COUGAR RIDGE underwent a three to four wide trip for to the quarter pole, folded. IN THE BEAT three wide on the first turn, was closer to the rail on the next one, gave way.
