LAST GUNFIGHTER came out of the starting gate with no apparent mishap, contently chased the pacesetter three wide on the first turn, under a good hold by the pilot, moved by BURNED BRIDGES and became the primary pursuer about halfway down the backstretch, kept close attendance from just off the leader's hind quarters around the far turn, entered the stretch and got called upon, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch drive, continued onward, collared a stubborn rival in ISN'T HE PERFECT in deep stretch and edged away, kept to a strong drive to the end. ISN'T HE PERFECT tucked along the inside soon after the start, and stayed along the rail the remainder of the event, patiently tracked the front runners until the quarter pole, turned for home with sufficient passage along the inside route, ARLO having drifted to be two wide at this juncture, was given his cue and took off with good energy to loom a bold threat by the end of the furlong grounds, forged his way to a slim advantage before completing the next sixteenth, offered solid resistance when the the top one drew even, making that rival earn his way to the front, before relinquishing, finished gamely to procure the place. ARLO kicked clear of the others to take the early advantage, was rated at or near the inside while showing the way, had the rider take hold momentarily spinning into the backstretch but otherwise went about professionally, drifted out into the two path by the bottom of the second turn, leaving the left flank exposed, had the runner up make a strong move during the ensuing furlong, with the eventual winner lurking dangerously just to the outside, yielded soon afterwards, but held on willingly for the show. SCOTUS saved ground until upper stretch and failed to menace. BURNED BRIDGES stalled the leader from the two path proceeding on the opening bend, gave up position to the top one shortly after reaching the backstretch, resumed the chase three wide on the second turn, came into the stretch and backed away.
