Footnotes

TWICE THE LADY came away in good order, sat reserved within striking distance from off the inside, under a firm hold around the first turn and down the backstretch, was at the crown of the second turn before getting released from the previously-described hold, crept up to the runner up and latched on in short order, entered the stretch still racing side by side with the same foe and got let out, was the first of the two to arrive at the eighth pole, albeit by a slim margin, dueled onward with WITHGREATPLEASURE while inching away, shied inward from a large shadow in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, swerving towards the rail slightly but enough, since both front runners were still in close proximity to each other, to cause the rider of the second place finisher to steady momentarily, kicked clear, crossing the finish line, hand urged. WITHGREATPLEASURE sat forwardly placed from the get-go, moved up and took over command midway down the backstretch, with the former pacesetter being eased back at this juncture, was sent over to the rail near the half mile pole, felt the winner's presence by a furlong later, argued to maintain the lead with some vigor but relinquished nonetheless, was still in the fight when forced to the inside a bit, put in tight by the briefly-errant winner, in the area of the sixteenth pole, had the rider steady momentarily while almost scraping the inner barrier, continued onward with good courage to be second best. STEPHANIE JAYNE the early leader, was put to a firm hold and allowed to ease back, conceding the front to the runner way midpoint down the backstretch, continued to track from the inside until the quarter pole, was already under urging angling outward for the stretch run, proved no match. R GYPSY GOLD quickly tucked along the rail and judiciously took the inside route around the first turn, got tipped outward coming into the backstretch and remained off the inside thereafter, was asked for some run proceeding her way on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch under strong handling, came up empty. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the stretch drive before the result was declared official. In addition, claims of foul lodged by both the rider and trainer of WITHGREATPLEASURE against the rider of TWICE THE LADY alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
