UNCLE MO broke running and wasted no time assuming control, sat entrenched in the two path, cutting the fractions on a loosely-contested lead, was put to the test by the runner up nearing the quarter pole, got tapped several times on the right shoulder spinning into the lane, drifting inward slightly as a result, lengthened away when set down to a vigorous hand ride, holding the lone stretch threat safely at bay for the decision. JACKSON BEND got off a beat slowly, after a stutter step start, remained unhurried taking the inside route during the initial stages, unleashed a strong rail run when released from a good hold on the reins at the seven-sixteenths pole, was nearly abreast of the winner, when caught behind that opponent's heels cutting the corner into the lane, altered course to the outside for racing room, continued onward with good courage, but had to settle for being second best. JERSEY TOWN loosely stalked the pacesetter, proved no match for the top twosome. GOLDDIGGER'S BOY three wide departing the backstretch, was put to a prolonged drive and tired.
