GUN RUNNER quickly opened clear to dictate terms, shrugged off the bid of STANFORD leaving the second turn, smartly drew away and was in hand the final yards. HONORABLE DUTY was allowed to settle, moved up four wide to make his bid, brushed with BREAKING LUCKY through the drive but kept on well to earn the place. BREAKING LUCKY attended the pace along the inside, shifted out between runners entering the stretch, brushed with HONORABLE DUTY through the drive and failed to make headway. HAWAAKOM broke a step slow, angled in to save ground, got through to make his move, was blocked and steadied near the furlong marker, altered course to the outside but lost his best chance. STANFORD tracked three wide, took a futile run at GUN RUNNER midway through the second turn, flattened once straightened for the stretch run and retreated. TEXAS CHROME was allowed to settle, angled out six wide but failed to threaten. MO TOM was never a factor. BIRD SONG settled between horses, but came up empty on the second turn and dropped out.
