KNOW MORE stalked four wide then three deep on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch, lugged in a bit in midstretch but rallied under left handed urging to get up late. HEIR KITTY pulled her way between horses early then stalked inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched clear and held on well but was caught late. MISS EMPIRE bobbled at the start, pulled some and chased a bit off the rail then inside, continued along the fence in the stretch and rallied for the show. HEIR OF STORM broke in and a bit slowly, pulled his way up inside and steadied when shuffled back midway on the backstretch, stalked inside, came out into the stretch, was between horses past midstretch, angled out some and lacked the needed rally. SCHERER MAGIC tugged his way along between horses and was shuffled back five eighths out, stalked between rivals to the stretch, came out some and could not offer the necessary response. AMARISH sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came off the rail in the stretch, battled in midstretch, then weakened. MORENO broke a bit slowly and bobbled, pulled his way between horses and steadied a half mile out, went four wide on the turn, angled in some into the stretch and lacked a further response. K COURT stalked three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and weakened.
