By subscription of \$150 each, which shall accompany the nomination, Closed Thursday August 21, 2014 with 16, or by supplementary nomination of \$25,000 each by closing time of entries, (Supplementary nominees do not have to pay the starting fee.

Supplementary nominees are automatically eligible to all future Golden State Series Stakes, subject only to regular nomination and starting fees). Footnotes

LONG HOT SUMMER stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch, came out again and rallied under left handed urging to get up in deep stretch. MY FIONA stalked the pace outside then three deep, bid four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch, gained a short advantage, fought back between horses in deep stretch and edged a foe for the place. LOST BUS stalked the leaders outside then three deep, bid three wide between foes leaving the turn and into the stretch, put a head in front past midstretch and was edged for second. EASTER FEVER broke slowly, angled in and moved up inside to stalk the pace, awaited room off heels on the turn, came out for room leaving the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. SINGING KITTY broke inward and bobbed in a slow beginning, went up inside then came off the rail on the backstretch to chase the pace, went three wide into the stretch and did not rally. GRAND YODELER dueled outside a rival then between foes leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. DESERT THIEF had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. PRINCESS BERTRANDO drifted in at the gap, stalked a bit off the rail or between horses, fell back between foes on the turn and also weakened.
