Footnotes

AMBERJACK in hand along the rail contesting the lead early, dropped back some after a half mile, eased out to two path midway on the final turn, took the three path into the lane splitting rivals, reached the leader in gear with a furlong to go and then drew off proving clearly best. SMOOTH BERT contested the lead along the rail, battled the winner briefly in midstretch and then finished clearly best of the rest. WEST HILLS GIANT checked at the fifteen-sixteenths pole, well placed along the three path up the backstretch, moved to challenge between foes midway on the last turn and then could not sustain the bid. GO GET THE BASIL was unhurried, gained along the three path leaving the backstretch, challenged three across midway on the last turn and then flattened out. TEQUILA HERO was unhurried along the two path up the backstretch, three path into the lane and tired. STREET LORD vied for the lead three across early, dueled after a half mile and then was done on the last turn.
