OFF THE JAK settled in and tracked the pace just outside of rival in early stages, shifted out slightly leaving the backstretch, moved up to be on even terms with leader, took command at the top of the lane and continued clear under brisk right handed encouragement. BAHAMIAN SQUALL allowed to settle in opening stages and stalk the pace, continued patiently in the backstretch, given cue to pick up the pace, fanned out six wide into the turn and rallied along the outside of rivals in the stretch but was too late to catch the winner. LITTLE DRAMA stalked the front runners along the rail in early stages, urged between rivals nearing the far turn, shifted out three wide at the top of the lane, gained ground under right handed pressure in the drive and lacked final kick to make serious impact. CLOSE IT OUT allowed to settle in early stages racing along the rail, began to pick up the pace going into the far turn, raced three wide into the lane and continued a steady bid for leaders in the drive. STAR HARBOUR was away awkwardly at the start, rushed up between rivals and took command, continued the leader by a slight margin over rival in the backstretch, challenged by OFF THE JAK in the turn, could not match strides and began to weaken in upper stretch. BLACK DIAMOND CAT stalked the front runners in early stages, made a outside bid nearing the far turn, raced five wide into the lane and flattened out in the drive. CAJUN BREEZE was unhurried in early stages and raced near the back of rivals, floated out six to seven wide into the far turn and failed to be a threat in the drive. COUNTY GUN urged along the inside toward the lead in opening stages, raced behind the top two

pacesetters and began to fade after a half mile. HELLO PRINCE lacked speed in opening stages, continued evenly near the back of the pack in the backstretch, saved ground along the rail in the far turn and lacked response in the drive. BERNIE THE MAESTRO was unhurried in opening stages and settled in near the back of the pack, raced three to four wide nearing the far turn and failed to make a bid in the drive. SHOCK'EMAGAIN pulled in opening stages and pressed the early pace, began to weaken after a half mile and gave way leaving the backstretch.
