BAHAMIAN SQUALL stalked the pace, saved ground throughout and kicked on gamely in the stretch to draw clear under strong pressure. FORT LOUDON stalked the pace, raced four wide in the lane and was no match for the winner. CLOSE IT OUT was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide in the stretch and closed in the gamely in the latter stages. GOOD LORD stalked the pace, raced four wide into the upper stretch and had no final winning bid. LITTLE DRAMA set all the pace from the outside and gave way the final eighth of a mile. BLACK DIAMOND CAT dropped back early, raced three three deep and never was a factor. THANK U PHILIPPE was slow early and never menaced. CAPTAIN GENIUS stalked the pace from the inside and tired. IMPERIAL CZAR showed little.
