STAKES My Charmer S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, December 3. \$1,000 to enter. \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds: 120 lbs. Older: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over on turf since June 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race at a mile or over on turf since June 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 24 feet).

Footnotes

ON LEAVE raced in midpack three wide early, edged closer under her own power while remaining in the three-path around the far turn, challenged outside GIANNA'S DREAM when set down turning for home, and was all out to reach the front in the closing yards. GIANNA'S DREAM moved over from the two-path clearing to the inside with the early lead, repelled a bid from DEFIANT HONOR approaching the stretch to regain command, then fought gamely inside ON LEAVE through a long drive while drifting out some. STORMY VICTORIA (FR) fought restraint being wrangled back to last soon after the start, lagged well back to the top of the lane, slipped through inside APRIL GAZE near the furlong marker and finished well belatedly inside the top two. APRIL GAZE stalked the leaders from close range for six furlongs, drifted off the inside under pressure through midstretch and was outkicked. INSIDE OUT saved ground moving closer to the leaders through the middle fractions, was roused in the two-path between horses through upper stretch and made no headway. JOSDESANIMAUX was reserved early two wide, remained within striking range shifting out to the three-path turning for home and came up empty. DEFIANT HONOR prompted the pace outside GIANNA'S DREAM from the outset, bid outside that rival with a quarter-mile remaining, then gave way steadily approaching the eighth-pole. SOUTHERN GEM saved ground early, and failed to gain while three to four wide approaching the stretch. PANCAKE took the initial bend three wide, was stacked four wide into the far turn and flattened out.
